UPDATES ON THIS WEEK'S LEARNING!

NURSERY TEAM UPDATE!

This week in Nursery, we have been looking more autumnal seasonal changes and exploring seasonal produce, such as gourds, using our senses. To develop our fine motor skills, we hammered golf tees into gourds of all shapes and sizes as well as predicting what colour each one would be inside. We also looked at size language of big and small, comparing items with our friends.

In Maths, we have been using number names and having fun with number rhymes. In Literacy, our focus has been on a new book called 'Hello Friend' by Rebecca Cobb. We enjoyed a sunny afternoon at Forest School - playing a game of sky fox and painting autumnal leaves.

RECEPTION TEAM UPDATE

This week in reception we have been looking at all things autumn. The children have had access to pumpkins outside, exploring the feelings of the insides, the smell and what they look like. They have seen different sized and colours, exploring the different seeds in each too.

They have also been doing leaf rubbings, sharing the different leaves and crayons to make their own masterpieces. They used different coloured crayons to try and get more detail.

We also explored autumn in forest school, looking at leaves and how they've changed since summer. The children described the texture, sound and smell of their leaves.

The children have also been writing their own fact files and pigs. They took their knowledge from last week of owls and have applied it to a new animal of pigs. They've developed lots of new vocabulary!

YEAR 1 TEAM UPDATE

The children have had a great last week of the half term. We have been busy writing persuasive letters to Mrs Allen, looking at part-whole models in maths and creating some of our own sketchbooks in Art.

The children have all worked ever so hard and settled in amazingly into our busy Year 1 routines. Miss Yates, Miss Pearson, and Mrs Deakin are so proud of each and every child's achievements throughout this term, so a big well done to our fab children!

YEAR 2 TEAM UPDATE

In Forest School, the children enjoyed creating their own bows. They have thoroughly enjoyed playing games and working hard as a team.

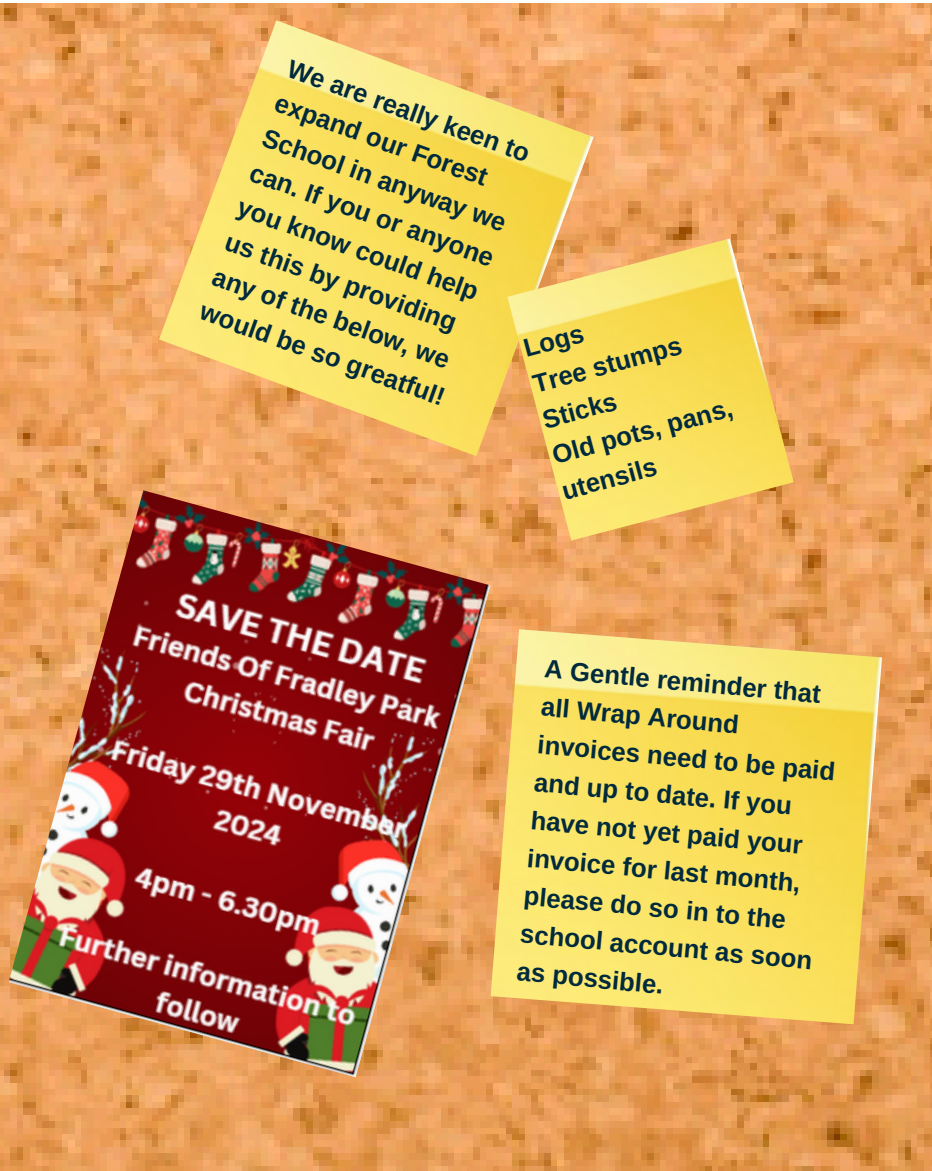

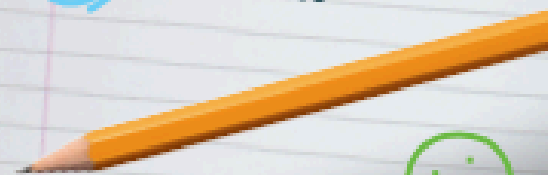
